

Award Nomenclature Guideline

Introduction

- (1) La Trobe University has approved standard nomenclature for all awards granted by the University. Approved award titles are used in all official certification for those awards, including academic transcripts, testamurs and Australian Higher Education Graduation Statements.
- (2) This guideline describes the standard nomenclature to be used for all types of La Trobe University awards recognised within the Australian Qualifications Framework. It should be read in conjunction with the La Trobe Course Architecture.

Nomenclature requirements for all awards

- (3) All award titles will reflect:
- the level of the award, according to the level in the Australian Qualifications Framework; and
 - the broad field of study, discipline or generic area.

Nomenclature requirements

- (4) Undergraduate Exploratory Course titles will include a tag that denotes the cognate major area or areas of study.
- (5) Undergraduate Specialist Course titles will include the name of the discipline.
- (6) Postgraduate Structured Courses titles will include the name of the discipline.
- (7) Postgraduate Semi-structured Courses titles will include a tag that denotes the chosen specialisation.
- (8) Postgraduate Flexible Course titles will not include a tag.
