- (3) La Trobe University is committed to:
 - a. Protecting the environment through the prevention of pollution and waste, and through the sustainable development, and maintenance and improvement of the natural and built environment.
 - b. Complying with all relevant environmental legislation, standards, agreements, policies and procedures.
 - c. Maximising sustainable resource use.
 - d. Minimising the use of hazardous substances.
 - e. Developing and implement climate change mitigation and adaptation strategies.
 - f. Protecting and improve biodiversity.
 - g. Developing and implement research and teaching initiatives related to sustainability.
 - h. Engaging with community groups and local government to develop sustainability initiatives throughout the region.
 - i. Objectives and targets have been established for improving our environmental performance in the areas of:
 - i. Energy consumption, Greenhouse gas emissions, Potable water consumption, Waste to landfill, Resource consumption, Sustainable transport, and Biodiversity.
